Micah Group was awarded a bid and bonded project to perform demolition and hazardous abatement at the Naval Weapons Station in Charleston, South Carolina. The work included lead and asbestos abatement; removal of 30 underground ammunition bunkers, 11,100 feet of railroad tracks (to include removal of the underlying stone ballast), buildings, pool, fence and associated apparatuses. Demolition included removal & recycling of all concrete slabs, footings and foundations. Work was performed using conventional mass demolition techniques.
